

8 THINGS YOU CAN DO NOW TO STOP THE PRIVATIZATION OF SOCIAL SECURITY!

- #1** Call your members of congress and say NO WAY to ANY Privatization proposal. Phone number is 202-225-3121. If your congressperson is on House Ways & Means or Senate Finance Committee, URGENTLY organize people to contact, write, and meet with these members.
- #2** Call President Bush and say NO WAY to ANY PRIVATIZATION PROPOSAL. No compromises! Phone number is 202-456-1111 (White House Comment Line).
- #3** Let the CEO of AARP, Bill Novelli, know you are THRILLED with the NO to Privatization position they have taken. Email: wnovelli@aarp.org . Also contact your State AARP Office and give them the same message, or ask them how you can help.
- #4** Get 5 friends and colleagues to do the same (#1,#2, and #3). Building a network of informed and committed citizens is the first step towards stopping the privatization of Social Security. Get the truth out!
- #5** Write a Letter to the Editor and/or Op-Ed for your local paper. If you would like to share, the website will be providing a database of Op-Eds, Letters to the editor, and other materials.
- #6** Organize and/or speak at: a) Teach In for students b) House party / Meet-up for colleagues, friends and others c) Speaker Trainings
- #7** Contact, inform and organize members of your personal and professional networks. Form a local “Hands off Social Security Coalition” with organizations and activists in your community. See the website for details on how to do this.
